Wychavon Parish Games 2024

We heard there are a number of people within our Parish who would love to take part in the Wychavon Parish Games.

The Games are a series of 15 events, which are competed for by residents of the various parishes within Wychavon. Events are: Angling; Bell Boating; Bowls; Crib; Cross Country; Ladies' Darts; Men's Darts; Dominoes; Men's Five-a-Side; Pétanque; Pool; Rounders; Skittles; Junior and Senior Table Tennis, with numbers of players varying from as few as 2 for the Pétanque and Table Tennis, to 10 for the Skittles. There is something for everyone, and participants enjoy visiting clubs, pubs and village halls in other parts of the District. Many Parishes start by entering just one event and then enter more in the following year. The entry fee remains at $\pounds10$ per event, with a maximum fee of $\pounds80$. This will be paid for by Bredon Parish Council.

W/24/00203 - Land At (OS 9348 3560) Watery Lane, Kinsham. PC Objects. The site is designated as Local Green Space and a key open space which should be kept free from development. A more detailed response has been submitted to Wychavon.

W/24/00105 - 10 Vallenders Road, Bredon. PC has commented. Residents objections were noted, and the concerns of neighbours Noise understood. and positioning of the Air-Conditioning Unit is a technical matter, so Wychavon requested apply the appropriate to standards and ensure the necessary compliance.

W/24/00251 - Quarryman's Cottage, Westmancote, Bredon. PC has no objection, but the windows should be hardwood and sympathetic to the existing units. The facing wall to the adjacent property should be solid rather than containing a window.

W/23/01798 - Croft Farm Leisure & Water Park, Bredon's Hardwick. PC objects, to the additional supporting statement from Zesta Planning. The site is designated as Local Green Space and is recognised as being key open space which should be kept free from development. A more detailed response has been submitted to Wychavon.
